

GARBAGE ROOM

The Garbage Room Is located on the main floor out the rear double doors down the walkway and requires a FOB to open it. This is open 24 hours a day. Please be advised that nothing is to be left on any table or area in the garbage room.

This is **NOT** a drop off for unwanted or re-used items as these items will end up in our garbage bins that are for household garbage only. **Contractors are not permitted to drop off items in the garbage room.** Any items left there will be returned to the owner.

- Plastic wrap, blue recycle bags and Styrofoam do not go in the recycle bins
- Please **break down** all cardboard boxes for recycling
- Garbage and Recycling is collected Tuesday & Friday Morning
- Blue bins located by the large overhead door are for glass food bottles, jars, batteries, light bulbs, small appliances and electronic equipment
